## barefree terms, conditions, information and tips

Welcome to barefree! We strive to provide a safe and fun environment for our community of guests. We provide a private primitive camping experience for our member community.

## **Code of conduct**

We welcome you as our guest at barefree (a private camping experience).

We want everyone to have a great time, to assure that, we require all guests to:

- Be kind.
- Respect others.
- Respect the camp & the hosts.
- Respect this No Drama Zone. Don't bring it, don't create it, and don't accept it (even if it's free). If you have a serious issue, contact a host.
- Engage in no illegal activities or bring/use illegal substances.
- No weapons or fireworks. No activity that is needlessly dangerous to others or the camp.
- No hunting. Respect all the animals here.
- · Discard all trash in trash containers.
- If smoking, respect non-smoking guests, and discard butts in marked recepticles.
- · Keep our camp clean, if you see trash, please pick it up.
- · Leave your camp area clean. Respect the place, leave no trace.
- Do not bring in wood. Outside wood could introduce disease. You are welcome to harvest wood from downed dead trees (do not make a mess please), or you may purchase wood.
- Do not cut or disturb any living trees or plants. Make your impact on the environment minimal.
- Do not create noise that could likely disturb others. No electronic amplification.
- · Keep our camp safe, fires are only allowed in the community fire-pit. Fires must be attended.
- Fires are prohibited during Red Flag warnings, or if conditions pose a danger of wildfires.
- Generator use is discouraged due to noise, if necessary use generators from 1pm-5pm only.
- Pets must be on-leash, and you must assure they do not cause a disturbance or a hazard.
- Be careful. This is a wild environment and there is the opportunity for injury.
- · Wear appropriate footwear whenever walking on natural surfaces.
- Enjoy wild animals from a safe distance. Do not engage, harass, or disturb wild animals. Wild animals can unexpectedly attack, bite, or eat you.
- Only put human body waste into the outhouse. Paper or other waste may not biodegrade quickly.
- Discard toilet paper and any other restroom waste in the provided disposal can near the outhouse. Do not put any paper or waste into the outhouse pit.
- No photography or recording, unless you have permission from all people in photo.
- If nude, carry a towel. Always sit on your towel, do not sit bare on the chair.
- Don't stare at other guests, or make others uncomfortable. Be kind, respect everyone.
- Do not touch anyone without permission.
- NO means NO, and no explanation is required or nor should be expected.
- If you enjoy alcohol, please consume within your limits. Acting unsafe, disrespectfully, or causing annoyance to other guests is not acceptable. Do not leave (and drive) impaired.
- No glass containers or bottles. Broken glass could create a dangerous hazard.
- Respect guest privacy. Do not gossip. What happens at barefree, stays at barefree.

Some items you may wish to bring to make your visit comfortable. barefree is approximately 30 minutes from any major stores. If you want it, bring it.

- Enough food, water, drinks, toilet paper for your stay. We can re-fill your water jug.
- Proper footwear. If you are planning on hiking in the woods, a good pair of boots.
- Charcoal & starter fluid for \$5/day you may use a charcoal grille (if available) for cooking. You may also cook at the community wood burning fire-pit, which has a grate.
- Saw & hatchet for harvesting firewood. You can also buy a bundle of wood for \$5.
- FRS 2-way radios some cell phone carriers do not have coverage in this area. With a 2-way radio you can stay in touch with your group. We monitor the FRS channels if you need assistance.
- Flashlights / spare batteries it can get very dark in the woods.
- Compass your phone GPS may not get reliable signal here.
- Sunscreen and bug spray.
- Medical supplies in case you experience any cuts, scrapes, stings, allergies, headache, etc.
- Phone or tablet if you want to stay connected. We offer free limited 5ghz wifi (coverage and availability at campsites may vary).
- A solar battery/phone charger. We do not have electrical service at campsites.
- Tent & tent supplies.
- Sleeping bag / sleeping pad / pillows / bedding.
- · Camp chairs, camp table.
- Tools Multitool pliers, knife, saw, axe/hatchet, tape, hammer, cord, small broom, trash bags, compass, FRS radios, flashlights/headlamp, extra batteries, solar charger, binoculars, etc.
- · Clothing, rainwear, work gloves, towels, soap, cleaning supplies.
- Fire starter (lighter), pot, pan, knives, forks, can opener, plates/bowls, mugs/cups, cutting board, water bottles/jug, wash bucket, dishwashing soap/sponge, ice and cooler.
- Toilet paper, toothbrush/paste, first-aid supplies, required medications, sunscreen, insect repellent, mirror, hair brush, baby wipes.

- As a guest you agree to assume all liability resulting from your visit or your actions.
- You agree to hold harmless and waive any right to legal action involving the facilities, the hosts, any agents of the hosts, other guests or any issues regarding activities occurring at barefree..
- You understand that you may be exposed to a variety of risks including COVID-19, diseases, or injury and medical services may be limited or unavailable.
- You understand barefree is a natural environment, you may encounter hazardous plants, terrain, or unpredictable wild animals.
- You understand that barefree is a ADULTS-ONLY CLOTHING OPTIONAL camping experience, and all persons in your group are 21+ years old. You are not concerned, disturbed or offended by this type of adult environment.
- Government issued photo ID will be required for ALL guests, to verify age.
- You agree to read and behave according to the barefree Code of Conduct.
- This is a private camp, you agree to not disclose the location of barefree.
- You understand that you are a guest visiting by permission of the hosts. The hosts may revoke
  this permission for any reason, or any time if they feel it is necessary.
- Fees paid are non-refundable. If you cancel within 30 days of your reservation any fees collected will be credited toward another visit within the current calendar year.
